WellPoint Systems Appoints New Chief Financial Officer

CALGARY, Alberta – July 17, 2008 – WellPoint Systems Inc. (WPS:TSX-V) today announced that it has appointed Mr. Bharat Mahajan, CA as its new Chief Financial Officer effective July 21, 2008.

He holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree from the University of Toronto and is a Chartered Accountant.

Mr. Mahajan recently independently acquired approximately 2.3 million shares of WellPoint in a private transaction.

The Board of Directors of WellPoint has also approved the issuance of 250,000 stock options to Mr. Mahajan. The options have an exercise price of \$0.275 per common share, and vest over three years.
